

Member Agreement

The undersigned agrees to the following terms and conditions that accompany the purchase of a CSA share for the 2018 growing season from Pollinator Produce Partners LLC (“Pollinator”):

Farm Commitment:

We at Pollinator commit to making every possible effort to provide a variety of produce throughout the 2018 growing season. As your farmers, we promise:

- ★ To grow only open-pollinated vegetables, and to prioritize biodiversity and open access to seeds through seed-saving, seed-sharing, and seeking out heirloom varieties whenever possible.
- ★ To refrain from using any synthetic pesticides, fungicides, herbicides, or fertilizers in the production of our crops.
- ★ To accommodate member requests and dietary concerns to the best of our ability.
- ★ To make ourselves available to answer member questions, to provide information on all the goods provided in the CSA, and to make the farm and distribution locations a welcoming, educational environment.
- ★ To provide timely delivery of shares at established distribution locations.
- ★ To do everything we can to provide the highest quality food at a reasonable price.

Member Rights and Responsibilities:

As a member of the Pollinator CSA, you are entitled to:

- ★ 24 shares of farm produce, distributed weekly at established distribution locations
- ★ Reserve any additional farm products (canned or baked goods, crafts, specialty items) before they are sold at market.
- ★ Farm visits, workshops, and member dinners at the farm location in Duffield.
- ★ Reasonable accommodations to your share.

As a member, we ask you to:

- ★ Provide full payment for your share: \$288 half share, \$480 full share, \$600 family share.
- ★ Pick-up shares at agreed upon distribution locations OR send a proxy OR give advance notice that you will forgo your share for the week.
- ★ Try new foods and cut down on food waste by sharing excess with friends and neighbors
- ★ Understand that your share is an investment in our farm: You have joined our community, which means sharing both the risks and the rewards. No refunds are available for missed pick-ups or unavoidable farm losses throughout the season. If crops come in in great excess, members will have the option of taking a portion of the bumper crops before they are sold at market.

Distribution Locations and Rules:

Distribution will occur at the same times and locations each week throughout the season, from May through October. Members are requested to choose the location most convenient for them.

Members may switch locations at any point in the season, as long as they give 48 hours prior notice. Members are also welcome to arrange a pickup at the farm in Duffield with 48 hours notice, in accordance with the scheduling needs of the farmers.

At the beginning of each week, members will be sent an email detailing what will be in their shares along with recipes, farm updates, and a listing of any non-share specialty items being sold by the farm that week. Members have the right to reserve any specialty items before they are sold at market by responding to the email.

It is the obligation of the farmers to ensure that the shares are always delivered in a timely manner. However, if there are extenuating circumstances that make it impossible to deliver shares at the established times, the farmers will contact all members within 24 hours to arrange an alternate delivery convenient for the members.

Delivery times and locations will be agreed upon by members and farmers by **April 1st 2018.**]
